At Angama Mara we welcome children aged six and over with arms open wide. We believe that connecting our young guests to the world's beautiful places and people is life-changing, not only for them, but for the adults experiencing the wilderness and all its wonders through the eyes of their children.



Our approach is to keep our young guests busy, tailor-making their stay according to each child's preferences and age. Parents are able to enjoy some time out too, or join in on the adventure which, over and above going out on safari, include:

- Bugging and tracking on nature walks with our Maasai naturalists
- Beading with the Maasai ladies in Angama Mara's Beading Studio
- Learning the art of spear throwing and shooting with a bow and arrow from a Maasai warrior
- Jumping and dancing with the Maasai warriors in our sundowner boma
- Baking bread or making ice-cream in the kitchen
- Picking fresh fruit, vegetables and herbs in the Shamba
- Learning about nuts and bolts in the workshop
- Visiting local schools and making new friends
- Playing soccer with the staff
- Learning about photography from our Angama Photographic Studio host
- Snuggling up in the Library with curated African books, DVDs and board games
- Stargazing at night with toasted marshmallows
- Going on a morning 'Run with A Kenyan'
- Or simply just being together as a family

Children's menus are offered to our young guests. Complimentary child-minding is included between 6pm and 10pm and Angama Mara has a total of four interconnected tents reserved for families travelling with children aged 12 and under, available on a priority basis.



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
