

Welcoming Kosher Guests



Angama Mara has a small kosher kitchen which caters for our kosher guests. This stand-alone kitchen is completely separate to the lodge kitchen and is fully equipped with everything needed for the preparation of kosher meals. This includes crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils, pots and pans, charcoal grill, cooking top, refrigeration and washing up facilities and is kept locked at all times other than when in use for our kosher guests. The kosher kitchen can prepare meals for up to 12 guests.

STANDARD KOSHER PANTRY INGREDIENTS

As there are no suppliers of kosher ingredients in Kenya all these need to be brought in from South Africa. The kitchen will be stocked with basic kosher pantry ingredients such as muesli, vinegar, pasta, peanut butter, honey etc.

We prepare a variety of vegetarian and fish dishes along with salads and fresh fruits. These are all prepared with olive oil and no dairy is used in the cooking of fish and vegetables.

There is **no surcharge** for the above.

IMPORTED KOSHER MEAT & DAIRY PRODUCTS

Should the guests like to order kosher meat, cheese and yoghurt these will be flown in from South Africa. At least 2 weeks' notice is required to place the order and ensure timeous delivery to the lodge.

The surcharge for this is **\$75 per guest per night**.



MEALS PREPARED BY THE BETH DIN IN SOUTH AFRICA

Should guests prefer to order ready prepared and sealed kosher meals from the Beth Din in Johannesburg this can be arranged and all costs for the guests' account. At least 4 weeks' notice required to place the order and ensure timeous delivery to the lodge.

Should the guests require the presence of a Rabbi or Mashgiach this can be arranged but with at least 6 months' notice. The related flights from South Africa, transfer costs and accommodation required would be for the guests' account.

KOSHER WINE & CHAMPAGNE

Kosher wines are available locally and served at no extra cost. Kosher French Champagne comes from South Africa and is for the guests' account. At least 4 weeks' notice required to place the order for Champagne and ensure timeous delivery to the lodge.

KOSHER GROUPS

In the event of a large group wanting to book (14 to 60 kosher guests) this will be handled by Angama Mara's CEO, Nicky Fitzgerald on a case by case basis.

PRE-TRAVEL CHECKLIST FOR OUR KOSHER GUESTS

Please specify the following:

- Are the guests happy to eat off our menu using standard lodge crockery and cutlery and just avoid pork and seafood?
- Are the guests happy to eat off our menu using standard lodge crockery and cutlery and eat only fish and vegetables?
- Would the guests require their food to be prepared in our kosher kitchen using standard pantry ingredients as listed above? (no surcharge)
- Would the guests like to order kosher meat (chicken, lamb and beef) and kosher dairy (yoghurt and cheese) from South Africa at a surcharge of \$75 per guest per night?
- Please could any kosher guests staying with us over the Sabbath please specify any expectations they have



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
