MARA ELEPHANT PROJECT (MEP)

Behind-the-scenes guest experiences providing insight into the gentle giants of the Mara and those who spend their lives protecting them



THE CONSERVATION FLIGHT

This once-in-a-lifetime experience offers two guests an authentic look into the protection of the gentle giants of the Maasai Mara. Marc Goss, CEO of MEP, will fly guests by helicopter over the Mara tracking collared elephants and explaining how MEP uses helicopters and technology to increase the protection of wildlife, communities, and the habitat of the Mara in order to mitigate human-wildlife conflict in rural Kenya. The flight will begin and end at Angama Mara, with an optional stopover at MEP Headquarters to further understand their important front-line conservation efforts

MEP MONITORING EXPERIENCE

Join MEP's monitoring team in the Maasai Mara as they collect data on the elephant population. The MEP team works tirelessly to find long-term solutions to protect the relationships between elephants and the neighbouring communities of the Maasai Mara. The experience includes an afternoon trip to MEP's Headquarters in Lemek Conservancy to meet the team, before heading out with them to conduct research which includes taking detailed photos of elephants, learning how to identify different individuals, as well as finding out more about the threats facing the fragile ecosystem
