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## WHAT SETS ANGAMA SAFARI CAMP APART:

- An intimate sole-use light-footprint movable camp set in the Mara surrounded by the astounding year-round wildlife
  - Set in the heart of the mega herds during the months of the annual Migration
  - Pitched on private camp sites deep in the remote wilderness areas of the Mara
  - Each day's programme is entirely up to the guests with a dedicated Safari Camp team, guide and vehicle
  - A fresh, uncluttered approach to safari camp design maximising the light and views thanks to the tents' landscape orientation
  - A four-layer tented roof system designed for maximum cross ventilation
  - Interiors that echo the fresh approach to design of Angama Mara with the best of everything but always just the right amount of everything
  - When in the Mara Triangle easy access to Angama Mara offering guests the best of both: days spent poolside at the lodge, access to the Photographic Studio, Fitness Centre, Beading Studio, Safari Shop, and much loved Shamba, and starlit nights back at Angama Safari Camp

  - Exclusive-use camp accommodating up to 8 guests in 4 ensuite tents
  - Light-footprint tented camp located in the Mara all year round
  - Pitched on exclusive-use wilderness campsites within the Mara
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## LOCATION & ACCESS:


- Daily scheduled flights from Nairobi's Wilson Airport to the closest airstrip to Angama Safari Camp's location
- 45-minute flight, depending on routing
- On average a 60-minute safari from the airfield to camp, depending on game viewing enroute
- Excellent air access from Nairobi and the Serengeti (via Migori in Kenya and Tarime in Tanzania)
- Accessible by road from other camps in the Greater Maasai Mara


