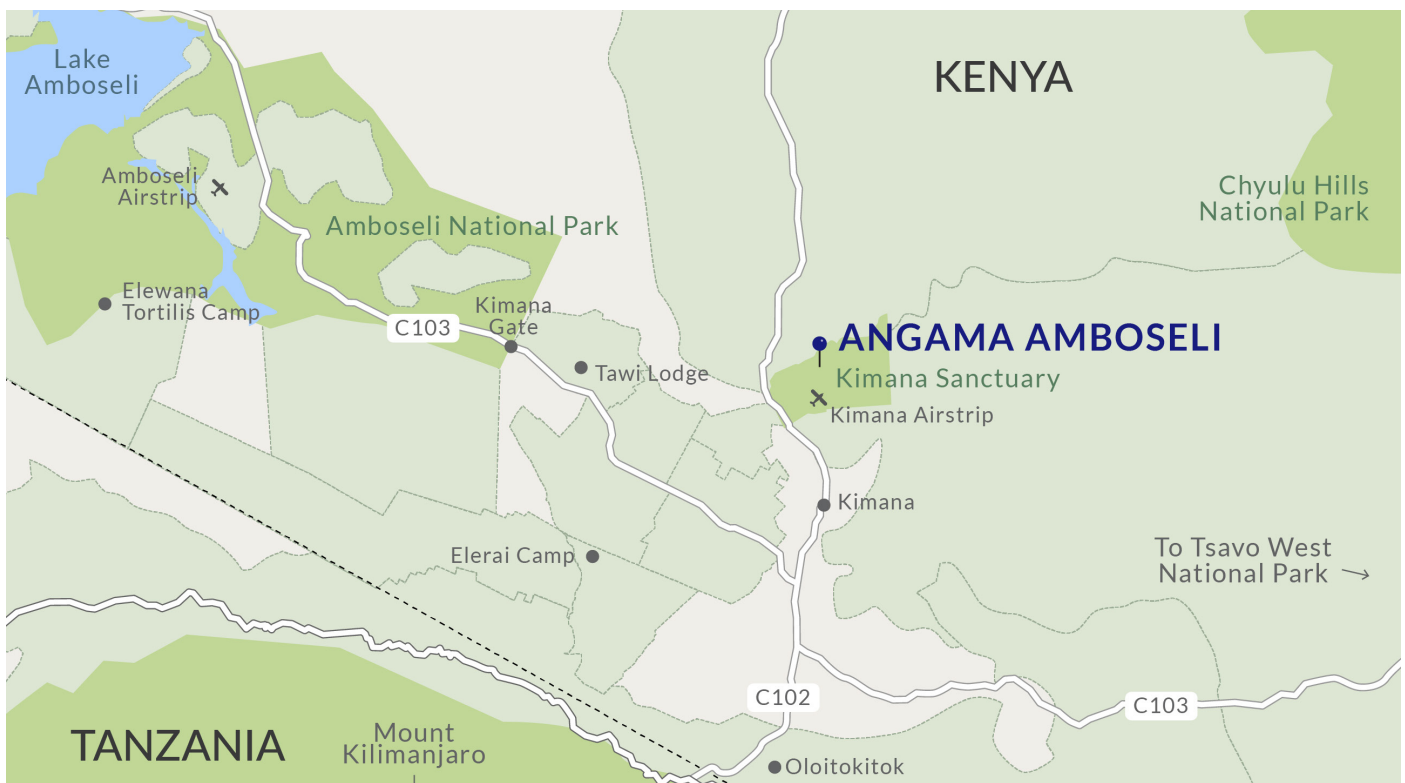

ALL YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Angama Amboseli is in the 5,700-acre Kimana Sanctuary, the jewel of the greater Amboseli ecosystem renowned for its lush landscape and remarkable diversity of wildlife, set against the famed backdrop of Mount Kilimanjaro (Kili)
- With just 10 tented suites, it's an intimate lodge with all of Angama's signatures: incredible views, contemporary African design, intuitive guiding and warm Kenyan service
- Another Angama signature: floor-to-ceiling screened doors of the suites make the most of the views of Kili. In fact, Kili, the tallest free-standing mountain in the world, is always in the picture, seen from anywhere and everywhere in camp and on game drives
- In the Guest Area, enjoy indoor-outdoor dining and of course, a baraza with a fire pit for telling stories while sipping cocktails or roasting marshmallows. There's also The Studios with a Safari Shop, Games Room, Photographic Studio, Art Gallery and a Makers' Studio
- Angama Amboseli has its own Photographic Studio with photographers on hand to assist with equipment hire, tutorials, editing sessions, printing and photoshoots
- One of our favourite spots is the Swimming Pool, with a drinking trough created specifically for our special guests: the elephants that also like to spend time in this area of camp. These are the stars of the Angama Amboseli show, both the hefty herds and the Super Tuskers – enormous bulls sporting tusks weighing 100lbs each
- Kimana means "stay a while" and this place is perfect for that: explore the Sanctuary, visit Amboseli National Park, take a pyjama safari (the best views of Kili are first thing in the morning when she peeks out from behind the clouds). Or just pull up a rocking chair and take in the view
- Angama Amboseli has exclusive traversing access to the Sanctuary, which is the heart of a vital migratory path for wildlife that connects Amboseli National Park to two other protected areas, the Chyulu Hills and Tsavo West National Park. With unrestricted access to the Sanctuary, guests can depart early in the morning and return after dark (night drives are encouraged)
- Amboseli National Park is a 45-minute drive from camp. Our guests can enjoy Amboseli on a half- or full-day excursion with a picnic lunch. Part of this journey visits the 'pinch point' – the narrowest part of a centuries-old migratory path connecting the entire Greater Amboseli ecosystem. This complex ecosystem is shared between humans and wildlife, agriculture and elephants, and highlights the realities of conservation in the 21st century

HOW TO GET HERE

Access is easy: it's a 3h30min drive on a paved road straight from Nairobi to the gate. There are also scheduled flights with Safarilink landing at Kimana Airfield in the Sanctuary, as well as Amboseli National Park and the Chyulu Hills, both about 1h30min drive away. Private charters are always welcome at the Sanctuary's Airfield.

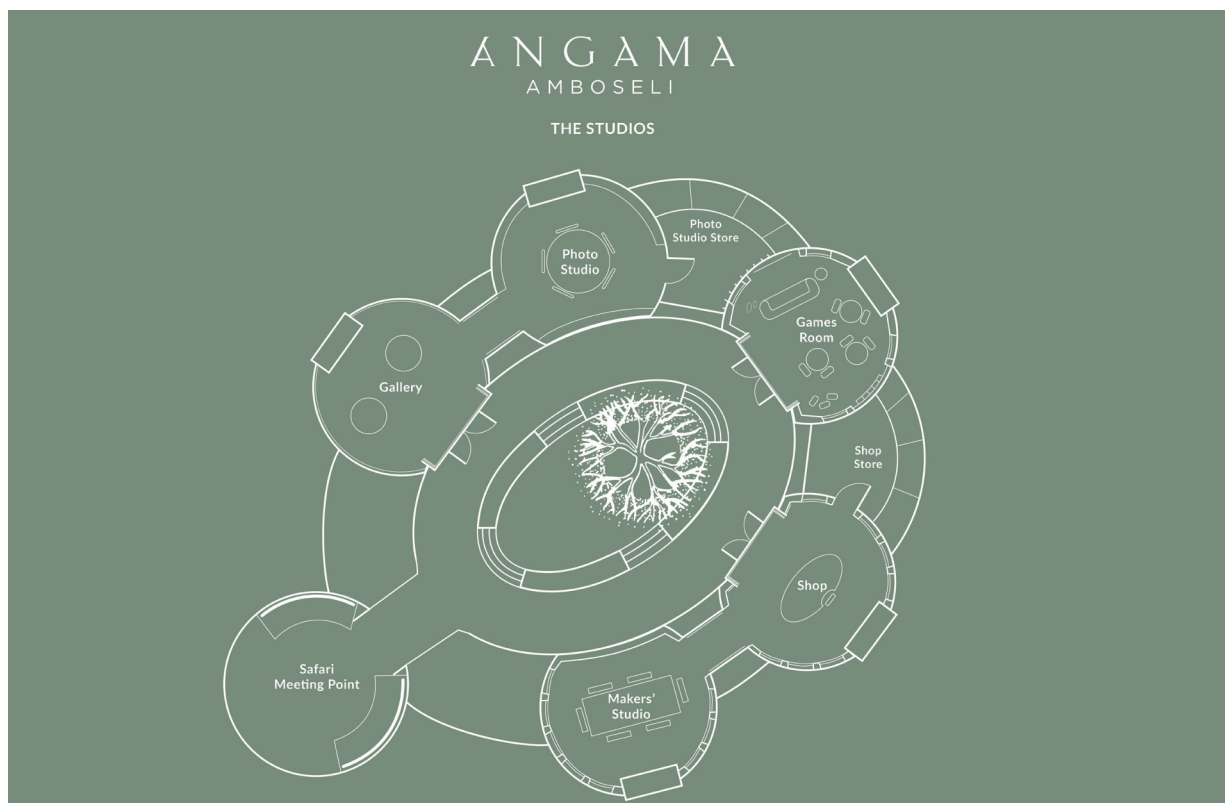

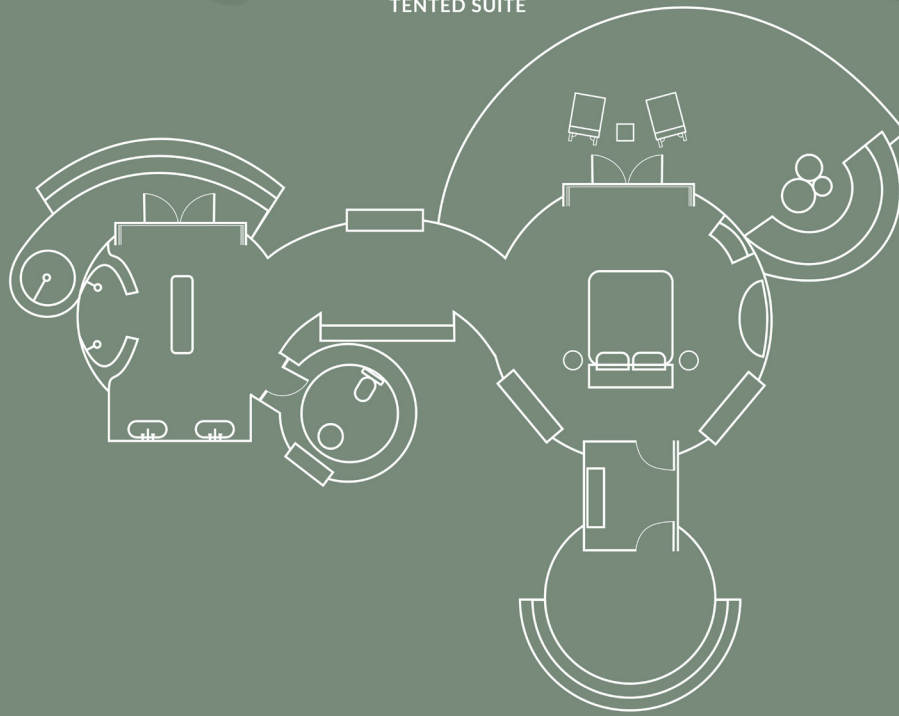

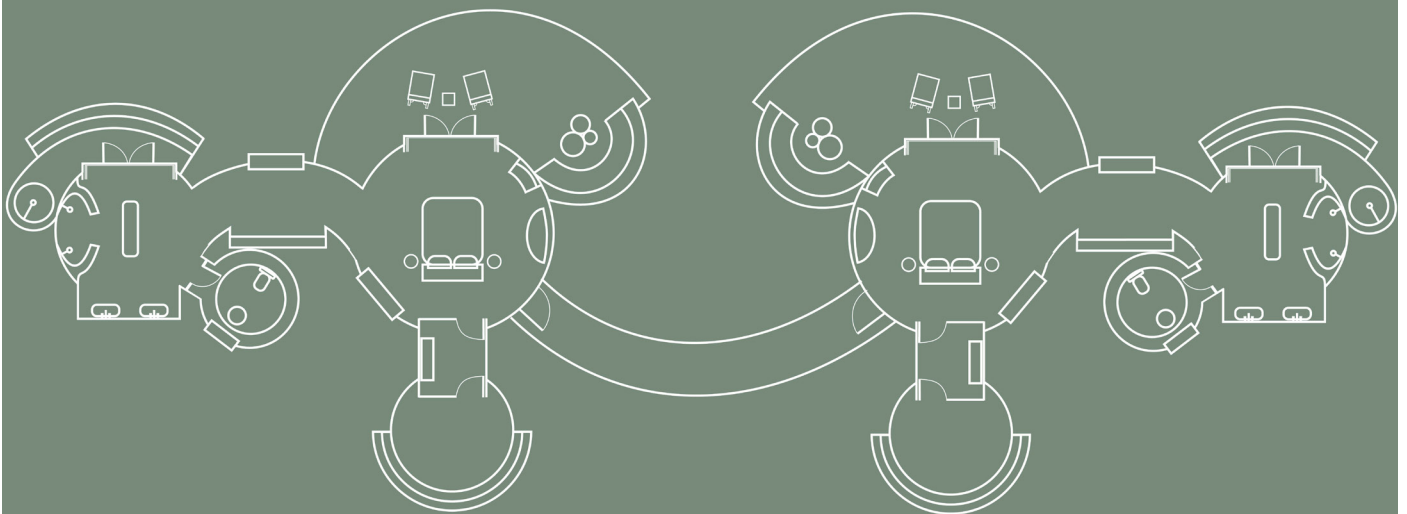

TRAVEL INFORMATION

Climate:	Warm and dry all year round
Altitude:	1,100m (3,608ft) above sea level
Rainfall:	Long rains: March – May Short rains: October – November Please note: rain generally occurs in brief afternoon thunder showers
Temperature:	Summer temperatures: min 17°C/62°F and max 30°C/86°F Summer: October – April Winter temperatures: min 14°C/57°F and max 24°C/75°F Winter: May - September
GPS Coordinates:	2°44' 30" S, 37° 32' 5" E
Malaria Protection:	Amboseli is classified as a malaria area particularly during the rainy seasons (March-May; October-November), seek medical advice prior to travel
Yellow Fever:	Many countries require travellers to have a Yellow Fever certificate prior to returning from a visit to Kenya
Currency:	USD, GBP, EUR & Kenyan Shillings
Passport & Visa Requirements:	Many nationalities, including the US and the UK, require a visa to enter Kenya. These cost US\$51 and are obtainable through an online portal. Please make sure your passport is valid for a minimum of six months after arrival in Kenya, with a minimum of three consecutive blank pages
